

POSSIBLE EXPOSURE	
<p>If you have:</p> <p>Been within 6 feet for 15 minutes or more from someone who has COVID-19 (laboratory confirmed or a clinically-compatible illness)</p>	<p>You should:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Immediately report this possible exposure to your instructor (if you are a student) or to your supervisor (if you are an employee), and:
<p>If you:</p> <p>Have been boosted OR Completed the primary series of Pfizer or Moderna vaccine within the last 6 months OR Completed the primary series of J&J vaccine within the last 2 months</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Continue coming to campus if no symptoms AND • Wear a mask for 10 days after date of last exposure to that person. • Test on day 5 after exposure, if possible. <p><i>If you develop symptoms, get tested and stay home.</i></p>
<p>If you:</p> <p>Are unvaccinated OR Completed the primary series of Pfizer or Moderna vaccine over 6 months ago and are not boosted OR Completed the primary series of J&J over 2 months ago and are not boosted</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Stay home for 5 days after date of last exposure to that person. * • If you continue to have no symptoms after 5 days, you can return to campus AND • Continue to wear a mask for 5 additional days. • Test on day 5 after exposure, if possible. <p><i>If you develop symptoms, get tested and stay home.</i></p> <p>*If a 5-day quarantine is not feasible, it is imperative that an exposed person wear a well-fitting mask at all times for 10 days after exposure. Approval to work from campus must be secured from the Company CEO or his designee.</p>

POSITIVE TEST WITH NO SYMPTOMS	
<p>Everyone, regardless of vaccination status.</p> <p>If you have:</p> <p>Been tested for COVID-19 and received a positive diagnosis but are currently not experiencing symptoms</p>	<p>You should:</p> <p>Immediately report this diagnosis to your instructor or supervisor, and:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Stay home for 5 days after the date you were tested. • If you continue to have no symptoms after 5 days, you can return to campus AND • Continue to wear a mask for 5 additional days. <p><i>If you develop symptoms after testing positive, your 5-day isolation period must start over.</i></p>
POSITIVE TEST WITH SYMPTOMS	
<p>Everyone, regardless of vaccination status.</p> <p>If you have:</p> <p>Been tested for COVID-19 and received a positive diagnosis and are currently experiencing symptoms</p>	<p>You should:</p> <p>Immediately report this diagnosis to your instructor or supervisor, and:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Stay home for 5 days after the date your symptoms first appeared. • If your symptoms are resolving after 5 days, you can return to campus AND • Continue to wear a mask for 5 additional days. <p><i>If you have a fever, continue to stay home until your fever resolves.</i></p>
NEGATIVE TEST WITH SYMPTOMS	
<p>Everyone, regardless of vaccination status.</p> <p>If you have:</p> <p>Been tested for COVID-19 and received a negative diagnosis and are currently experiencing symptoms</p>	<p>You should:</p> <p>Immediately notify your instructor or supervisor that you are experiencing these symptoms, and:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Stay away from campus until your symptoms have improved.
