## AMERICAN RESCUE PLAN (ARP) ACT

On Thursday, March 11, 2021, President Biden signed into law the American Rescue Plan (ARP) Act, to deliver critical aid to States, districts, schools, educators, students, and families as the country continues to recover from the COVID-19 pandemic. This act provides institutions with funding for students identified as having exceptional financial need. This emergency grant can be used to cover any component of a student's cost of attendance, including tuition, food, housing, health care or childcare education expenses, course materials, technology, etc. A student may also choose to apply the grant to an outstanding tuition and fee balance.

HCI College will award ARP grant funds to eligible students as outlined below until funds have been depleted. Once the ARP grant has been awarded, checks will be mailed to the address we have on file.
